

# WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR VACCINATION

## Before heading to the Vaccination Centre (VC):

- ✓ Bring your ID
- ✓ Wear short or loose sleeves that can be rolled up
- ✓ If you are unwell or had a fever in the last 24 hours, reschedule the appointment using the same booking link

### STEP 1



#### Check-in

At the VC, check-in with SafeEntry and scan your temperature.

### STEP 2



#### Medical Screening

VC staff will ask you a few medical questions to ensure you can take the jab.

They will check your name and ID.

### STEP 3

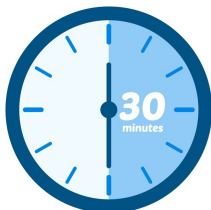


#### Take your Jab

When prompted by the staff, head to the vaccination booth to get your jab.

Don't worry, it doesn't hurt!

### STEP 4



#### Observation

You will be monitored for about 30 minutes after your jab. If you need attention, raise your hand.

Relax, or bring a book for the wait!

### STEP 5



#### Discharge

VC staff will check on how you are feeling and give instructions for your next jab.

That's it, you're done!

**Note: If the student wishes, they can consult the doctor present at the VC to further assess suitability.**

## After your vaccination:

Side effects like headache, fever and muscle ache are common and should resolve after a day or two. See a doctor if the side effects persist or get worse.
